



## UNIQUE OR NOTABLE ITEMS:

**Cul De Sacs:** dead-end streets with only one inlet/outlet. Common in residential suburban neighborhoods.



**Row Houses:** a row of identical or mirror-image houses which share side walls. Common in Baltimore, MD.



**Big-Box Stores:** physically large retail establishments, usually part of a chain (e.g., Wal-Mart, Target).
